



Rally In The Country

Wayne-Holmes Soap Box Derby Association May 7th & 8th, 2011 - Wooster, Ohio

Welcome to the spring 2011 edition of "Rally In The Country", presented by the Wayne-Holmes Soap Box Derby Association. This race will be held on a street track within a newly developed Wooster, Ohio business area overlooking the countryside of Wayne County, Ohio. This 2 day event will feature 3 races, The 1st race run on Saturday will be run double elimination, the 2nd Saturday race event will single elimination and on Sunday our 3rd race will be run double elimination with all three races being run as timer swap heats utilizing a 2-4-2 wheel swap system. Competitions are scheduled for Stock, Super Stock and Masters divisions and is open to all qualified entrants. Awards will be presented to 1st through 8th Place finishers in each division.

Registration:

Entrants may pre-register via mail (see discount below) or register the day of the race. All entrants must fill-out the "Rally In The Country" Registration and the AASBD Official Rally Registration. A copy of each entrant's Birth Certificate must be supplied unless already on file with the AASBD.

Times:

Track opens at **7am** for registration and check-in.
Registration and check-in ends at **7:45am** Racing scheduled to begin by **8:15am**

Inspections:

Cars will be inspected prior to racing. Check your car before arriving and for guidance use the 2010 AASBD inspection sheet from the assembly instruction booklet, available at www.aasbd.com

Entry Fees:

(Day 1 - Race Event 1 - Double Elimination) \$35 per contestant. \$30 for each additional sibling.
(Day 1 - Race Event 2 - Single Elimination) \$30 per contestant. (No sibling discount)
(Day 2 - Race Event 3 - Double Elimination) \$35 per contestant. \$30 for each additional sibling.
(Pre-Registered) \$30 per contestant per race event

Pre-Registrations must be submitted with paperwork & payment, postmarked by May 2nd.
Pre-Registered entrants must check-in by 7:45am on race day.
Refunds will only be made in case of cancelled race event.

Rally In The Country - Rules & Guidelines

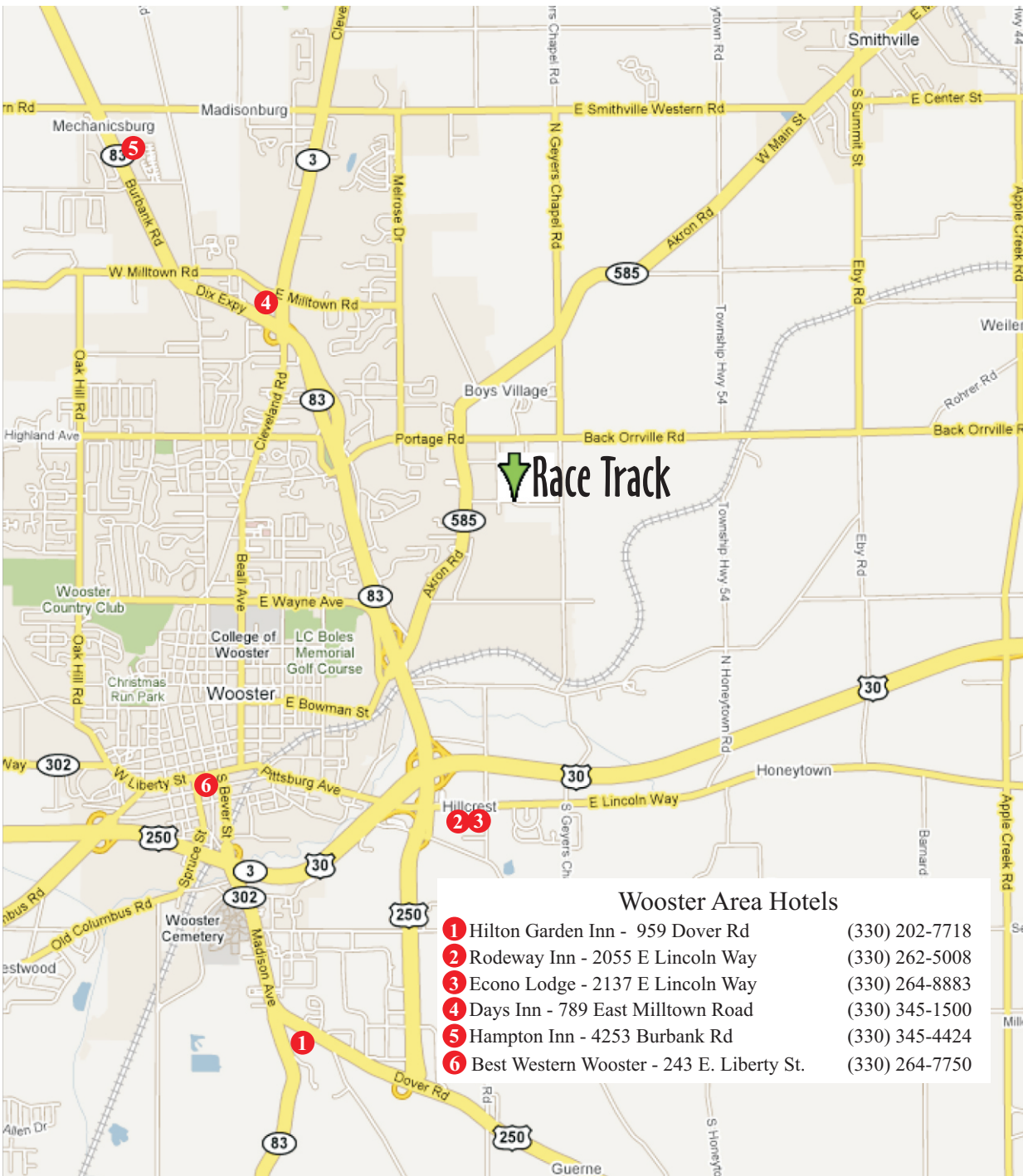
(Racers, Car Handlers and Race Families must read these rules and are bound to them regardless of if they have read them or not.)

1. All-American Soap Box Derby rules and standards apply.
2. All cars will be inspected before race begins and must have inspection sticker on car before being allowed to race. Winning cars will be subjected to a post race inspection.
3. Wheel position stickers will be issued at registration/check-in and must be placed to indicate the outside of each wheel position.
4. Once racing begins, no tools will be allowed in the pits and no working on cars will be allowed, except for repairs that are handled under the supervisor of race officials.
5. Trial runs will be allowed for first-time (no experience) drivers only.
6. Byes or warm-up runs will not be run, except for the winner of the winner's bracket (at their option).
7. No immediate family member racers will be paired in the first round.
8. No lubrications are to be used on axles or any part of the wheels after the start of the race.
9. All cars will be tail weighted (full) and marked prior to racing.
10. 15 pound max tail limit for all divisions.
11. Z-Glass wheels used for all racing. (No Wheel Bank available)
12. (2-4-2) Two wheels will be swapped prior to the first phase of each heat, as determined by racers drawing. All four wheels will be swapped prior to the second phase. Wheels will be returned to their owner at the end of each heat.
13. No spinning of wheels after wheel swap, including between phases.
14. Damage to wheels will be settled between the family of the driver responsible and the owner of the wheels.
15. A driver that damages the racing wheels between phases will be disqualified from that heat.
16. No touching wheels in ramps.
17. Bad start called by official starter is rerun in same lanes and with same wheels.
18. No loose articles are allowed in the car, except for clothing that was weighted with the car.
19. No rocking, bobbing or ducking on the ramps or during the race.
20. Crossing both center lines with two wheels will result in immediate disqualification from heat.
21. In the event that a derby car, its driver, or any object that moves by the influence of a derby car or its driver, hits or collides with any part of the finish line timer system, the driver will be disqualified from that race heat. Any driver damaging the timer system will be financially responsible for repair or replacement costs.
22. Both phase races of a heat must be completed within a 30 minute time limit. If due to weather delay or other uncontrollable circumstance both phases are not run within the 30 minute time limit, the heat will be void and both phases will be run again. If the delay is due to a racer making repairs, the second phase and heat will be forfeited by the driver unable to complete the race.
23. If a derby car must go to the pits for repairs, drivers are limited to 20 minutes for pit repairs between each phase or heat. This time limit starts as soon as the car enters the pits.
24. Stay with your car. If driver with car do not report to the scales/ramp within 5 minutes of being called, the driver will forfeit the heat.
25. No electronic devices allowed inside the race cars.
26. No coaching beyond front of starting ramps.
27. Verbal abuse of any child will NOT be tolerated. This includes within a race family. Verbal intimidation or harassment of another racer is prohibited.
28. No skateboards/roller blades or wheeled shoes allowed in pits, staging areas, ramps, run out area or near any cars.
29. Refer all problems to the Rally Director.
30. The Rally Director has the right to alter the racing format or anything as needed, i.e. loss of daylight. Our goal is to have SAFE, FAIR and FUN races all weekend.

The Rally In The Country is to be held on a street track set up on Benden Drive along the northeastern edge of Wooster, Ohio. You can use the address of **2845 Benden Dr. Wooster, OH** as reference for the race location. The race location is just off of state route 585 and this street track runs from west to east on the lower section of Benden Dr. between Eagle Pass & N. Geyers Chapel Rd. Parking will be available in two large business lots near the top of the race track. Race officials will direct those with trailers or RV's when they arrive. There are a number of nice hotels in the area and many restaurants near most of the hotels. For those navigating with a GPS: N 40 49 22.88 W 81 54 4.75
